Parents Maths Workshop – Wednesday 8 February at 3.30pm

We've had a number of parents who have expressed an interest in learning more about how we teach maths at school. We've also had a few parents who have asked us about the methods we use to teach maths, so we have decided to host a maths parent workshop straight after school on Wednesday 8 February. The session will be led by Mrs Flower, but all our teachers will be in attendance to answer any class specific questions and share some of the activities you may see in your child's class. The aim of the session will be to explore our approach to teaching maths and the rationale behind it, we will give you a chance to experience some hands on activities with your children by using the resources we use with them in school, have a chance to ask any questions and hopefully show you that the way we teach maths leads to a greater and deeper understanding of the subject. The session will be in Rowan class and will start at 3.30pm and should be finished 4.30pm. There will be refreshments available and we hope to see as many of you there as possible.

Arriving late in the morning

We have noticed a growing number of students arriving late for school in the morning. Learning starts as soon as the children walk through the door with, what we call our SODA (start of the day) activities. Changing Times for Sew Sublime

Sew Sublime (our uniform providers) have sent us the following message:

“We will be taking orders as normal through the website so parents can continue to order on line as we know how much they really welcome this service, (over 85% of our school uniform orders came from online sales this year) but we will be phasing out the town centre store over the next few months. We will no longer keep large amounts of stock but we will be making one school delivery every month with all orders individually labelled, as they are now, with the child’s name on the outside of the bag. We will collate orders from 20th of the month to the 19th of the following month and deliver those orders by the end of that month i.e any parents ordering between 20th January and 19th February will receive their orders delivered to school at the end of February. We will still include free name labels with the clothing orders, but we will no longer be offering a home delivery option. We will be closing the town centre store before the summer so we will be asking all parents to place their school uniform orders ready for the September start before the end of June. Their orders will then be delivered to school before the school break up for the summer holidays in July. We do have stock left in store at the moment and so we may be able to fulfil orders quicker than specified above for a while but we wanted to make you aware of the changes as soon as the decision had been made.

So the great news is that parents will still be getting fabulous top grade uniform for the same low prices they have enjoyed for over 5 years, still be dealing with a local company with customer service at the heart of our business and you will not have any additional workload to deal with as the parents will still order online and you will get the orders delivered straight to school as you do now, but once a month, at the end of the month. We thank you once again for your support throughout 2016 and we look forward to working with you in 2017.”
