Recruitment

We have a great track record when it comes to recruiting new students to our school. In fact the school now the most number of students it's ever had, but unfortunately, that is still not enough. Schools are funded on the number of students they have and as such when we lose students that has a big impact on us financially. This year 16 students will leave us from year 6 and if we don't replace them with 15 or more students coming into Orchard Class next year, we could suffer in terms of our overall funding. I won't know our final student number for September until mid-April. Each additional student brings funding of around £3000 of funding with them which can be spent for the benefit of all our students. If we managed to find an additional 10 students on top of our September intake, that's an additional £30,000 or so, which is a lot of money for a school our size. As a school we have a number of plans for upcoming events to showcase our school and more details about those we will be shared soon, but in the meantime, I am calling on your support to spread the news of our wonderful little school and share your experiences with other parents who may be looking for school places in September or are looking to move their children from another school. We really do need your help in securing the long term future of HPS and I hope you feel as passionately about it as we all do in school. Thank you.
