#### SECOND HAND UNIFORM

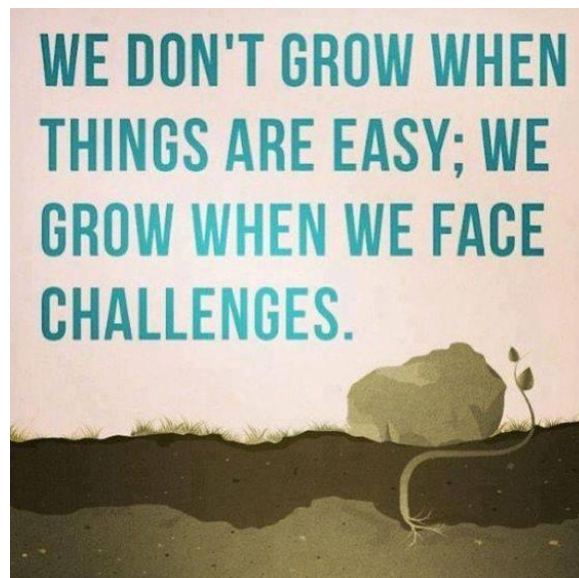
