The School Wall



Exciting new after school club in partnership with Oxford United Football Club

I am pleased to be able to say that Hornton Primary School is now working in partnership with Oxford United Football Club to provide an after school football club in September. OUFC will provide coaches and all equipment to run the club which will take place on a Monday after school from September. The club will take place at the pavilion field between 3.30pm and 4.30pm. We are currently waiting on Oxford United to complete the setting up of their online payment system before we send all the details to parents. The club will be open to anyone from Years 4 to Year 6 in September, but will have a limit of 16 spaces allocated on a first come first served basis. I will let you know, via a letter from OUFC, when we will be taking bookings to for the club. Later in the year, we are also hoping to run some PSHE sessions which will be led by OUFC coaches. We are also planning to be able to offer special match day experiences as a result of our partnership with the team. More details about this will be sent home in September.
