They have independently shown a respect for the rules and the safety and risk-taking aspect of using such equipment. A huge success, thank you Mr Fox.

The climbing wall is a 'Traverse Climbing Wall', which means children move sideways along the structure, as opposed to climbing vertically. With the climbing height only being a couple feet off the ground, this makes it perfect for all children to access safely, whilst still adding challenge and opportunities for thinking about risks.

As with all equipment, the children are not to access the climbing wall before school.
