Parking

After last week's stern reminder about parking on the yellow lines, I am pleased to say there has been an improvement this week. I have only had to remind a couple of people not to park on the lines. I am conscious that last week I did not offer any kind of solution to the issue. I have spent the week considering how together we could do more to reduce to the amount of cars parking in the village. My ideas are below and I am open to any others from you.

1. If you live in the catchment area of the school consider signing up to use the school bus, if you haven't already done so;
2. Use the village green as roundabout to drop your children off at the entrance to Church Lane and then leave the village as soon as they have been dropped off, so there is no need to park – I know a few parents already do this and I am grateful to them. By creating a 'drop off' zone, we'd reduce the amount of cars needing to park and we would go some way to developing a sense of independence we spoke about a few weeks ago in the bulletin;
3. Consider car-pooling with neighbours who live close to you. You bring your children and your friends children to school on one day and your neighbour does the other day;
4. Park at the pavilion and walk up to school – the children are quite used to walking this trip and it is only five minutes away

I'd like to take this opportunity to remind parents that we share the village with the villagers and if you need to park in the village, that you do so courteously by not blocking access to driveways.
