Class Dojos

I have had a request from parents for more clarity around how children can collect Class Dojos in Oak, Willow and Rowan class, so I asked my teachers. These are their responses:-

Mrs Hoof in Oak Class – ‘In Oak Class, children receive dojos if they follow classroom instructions, helping to tidy up, stay on task throughout a lesson, show great teamwork and they can gain 5 dojos if they complete all three challenges set during their 'Over To You' time. As well as the 10 dojos for 5 reads a week’

Mr Fox in Willow class – ‘In my class children can earn dojos for great work, humility, demonstrating the P.E. values we have for the lesson, perseverance, being purposeful, self-belief, general good behaviour, and for getting changed for P.E. within 5 mins.’

Mrs Flower in Rowan Class – ‘In addition to homework Dojos, children in Rowan are awarded Dojos for: Appropriate behaviour in the classroom and cloakroom – walking and working with purpose (a daily Dojo reward for those who make the right choices). Ad hoc Dojos (these all fall under certain categories, such as the ones that Mr Fox has referenced, above). We award the hundred milestones in our KS2 celebration assembly, every Friday.

I hope that helps and adds more clarity for those parents who asked.
