Oxfordshire County Council is now accepting applications for Reception entry in September 2019. You can apply on-line at [www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/admissions) as this is the most secure way of applying, further information is available on OCC's admissions website. The **closing date of Reception applications is 15th January 2019**, and the National offer date is 16th April 2019. **The 15th January closing date is extremely important, as late applications will not be considered until May 2019 after the first offers have been made.** Parents who make a late application are less likely to be offered a place at one of their preferred schools. Making an on-time application would be very much appreciated.

It is PARENTS responsibility to make an application. The attendance of your child at a Nursery or school does **NOT** mean that you do not have to apply for a Reception place. If you have any queries please do come and see us.
