Just under a year ago, I asked for your support with some postgraduate research - the implications for assessment when teaching for mastery in maths. As part of this, I examined assessment procedures and products used within our school and considered the way in which our teaching aligns. I analysed resulting test data from Key Stages 1 and 2 and explored the impact of these tests on children's perceptions of themselves as mathematicians.

I am writing to formally say thank you for your support, which culminated in my graduation, last Saturday, with a Master of Arts in Education (mathematics). As my research focused on something for which little has been written, the university has suggested I publish my findings in a mathematics journal: something I hope to do over the next few months. Having genuinely enjoyed the experience, I have also now made the decision to commence a part-time PhD (postgraduate doctoral research) later this year alongside my teaching commitments.
