Attendance

There is a clear link between pupils' achievement and their level of attendance at school. The governors and staff, alongside The Trust, firmly believe that all pupils benefit from regular attendance. We want all pupils to achieve the very best they can and for this they need to be in school regularly; at least 95% of the time. Last week I asked Mrs Bowes to give me attendance information of any child in school with less than 95% attendance for the year to date. There are 26 children with attendance less than 95% from September 1st until March 15th. That is nearly one quarter of the school population from Reception to Year 6. Some children's attendance is as low as 81% which is the equivalent of missing a day a week, every week since September or 20% of **ALL** the learning that has taken place since September. I will be writing to parents of all 26 children next week insisting that there is an improvement. I hope and expect to see a drastic improvement in the attendance of some of our children next term.
